Bird of Paradise Postcard

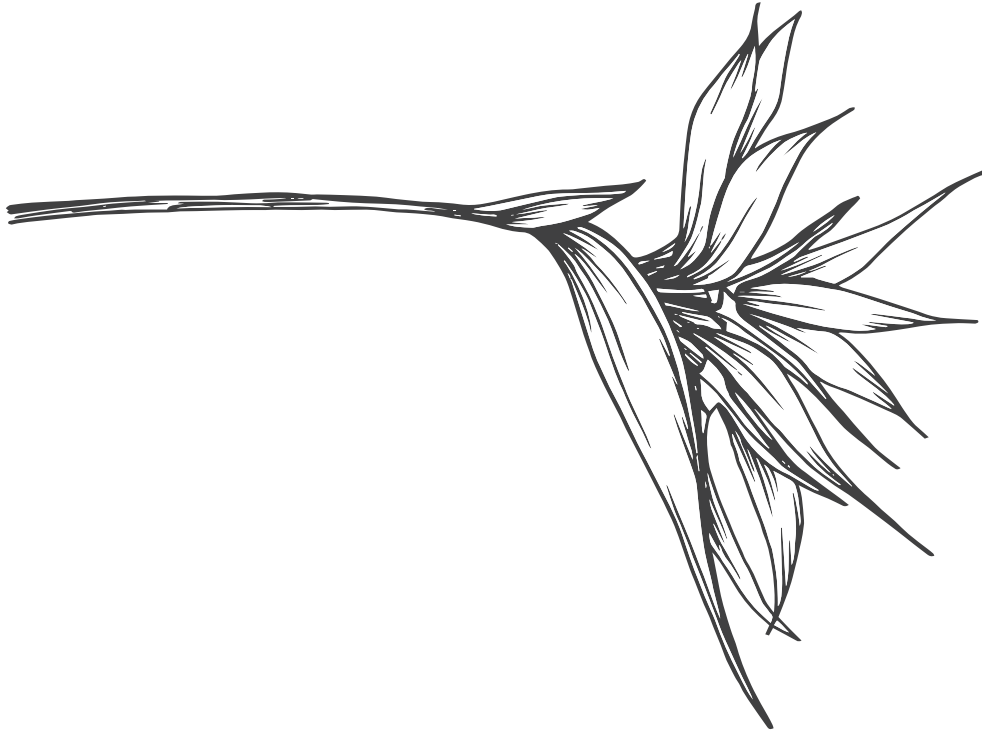
