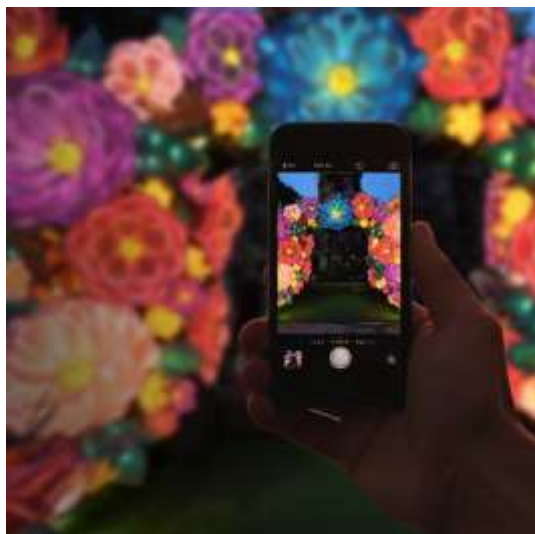
Guzheng Performance
